ADD-A-BID FORM

Have a small business? Want to help several members but can't afford to buy an individual animal or can't make the auction due to other commitments? Are you a grandparent, aunt or uncle who would like to support your family member's project but can't afford to purchase an entire animal? We have a solution for you. Add-a-Bid will allow you to add \$50, \$100, \$200 or any other amount you would like to the end bid of any youth project that is auctioned at our Youth Fair.

For example: Julie has a steer; John has a pig and Jim has a sheep. You would like to help all three, but it isn't within your budget to afford all three projects. Now you may do an Add-a-Bid for any or all three.

Julie's steer sells for \$1 per pound @1,200 lbs. for a total of \$1,200 during the auction. An Add-a-Bid may then be added to Julie's project in either a dollar amount or by the pound. For example, you could either give \$50 or \$.10 per lb. for a total of \$120. Once your Add-a-Bid is received, it will be sent directly to Julie.

Add-a-Bids may be turned in the night of the Large Animal Auction at the buyer's table or sent to Alicia Kantola, Treasurer of the Muskegon County Livestock Committee at 9682 E.
