- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs.
- All dogs will be required to wear proper training collar when in their classes. This means buckle collar or agility lead for agility, a breed appropriate collar for Showmanship and a training collar for obedience.
- All dogs are expected to be on their best behavior, dogs showing any aggression will be asked to leave.
- Proper care and treatment of dogs on the premises is expected.
- Recommend dogs have all their vaccines. No puppies under 3 months.
- 1st through 5th place ribbons in all classes, prizes for Championships.
- ALL MUSKEGON COUNTY FAIR EXHIBITORS MUST HELP WITH SHOW SETUP AND CLEANUP.

Directions

1. Muskegon County Fairgrounds ~ 6621 Heights Ravenna Rd, Fruitport Michigan
2. The Dog Arena is in the back of the Fairgrounds next to the Fair Office.
 - a. Best to enter Fairgrounds from the south entrance off S. Hilton Park Rd.
3. From Muskegon - Take Heights Ravenna Rd East toward Ravenna. Before you get to the Fairgrounds, take a right (South) turn onto S. Hilton Park Road. Then turn left (East) onto the first dirt road. Follow signs to the arena.
4. From Ravenna - Take Heights Ravenna Rd. West toward Muskegon. Go past the Fairgrounds, take a left (South) turn onto S. Hilton Park Road. Then turn left (East) onto the first dirt road. Follow signs to the arena.
5. From Grand Rapids - Take I-96 West toward Muskegon. Take Exit 10 - Nunica & turn right onto 112th Avenue (also known as Maple Island Rd.) Continue on 112th Avenue until you come to the 4-way Stop at Height Ravenna Road. Turn left (East) onto Heights Ravenna Rd and go past the Fairgrounds. Take a left (South) turn onto S. Hilton Park Road. Then turn left (East) onto the first dirt road. Follow signs to the arena.
